

CANNABIS SUPPLY CHAIN

Cannabis products are rigorously tracked from seed to sale, ensuring regulatory compliance, as well as preventing illegal cannabis from finding its way to stores shelves and keeping legally-produced products out of the underground market. The sophistication of tracking software allows the tracking of not just an edible brownie, but the plant that went into that brownie.

Because the cannabis industry is changing rapidly and laws vary by state, always check local laws to verify your state's requirements for scale readability.

GROWERS



Cultivate the plant and sometimes process the flower themselves, but often sell the raw material to a processor
Uses: Mixing fertilizers, Checking moisture content of flower, Packaging and Shipping
Products: Highland / GBK / GFK / LBX / CPWplus / WBW / PTS / PMB

MEDICAL LABORATORIES



Research cannabis and its compounds for medicinal applications
Uses: Weighing, Checking moisture content
Products: Highland / PMB

PROCESSORS



Trim, dry and cure the plants to ready them for manufacture into consumer-ready products
Uses: Pre-packing, Packaging and Shipping, NTEP-approved
Products: Highland / CPWplus / LBX / GBK / GFK

MANUFACTURERS



Package the flower into finished products or incorporate the processed material into products such as edibles, extracts, vape cartridges, oils and topical creams
Uses: Weighing ingredients, QC, Checking moisture content, Packaging and Shipping
Products: WBW / Highland / Astro / PMB / CPWplus

DISTRIBUTORS



Ships, warehouses and collect payment for products on behalf of the processor
Uses: Packing and Shipping
Products: Latitude / Cruiser / GBK / CPWplus / BKT

DISPENSARIES/RETAILERS



Sell the finished product to patients and consumers
Uses: Weighing products for sale, NTEP-approved
Products: Highland / WBW / Raven
